Update: Financial Aid for Haiti

In connecting with Pastor Abraham (Regional Director of SPI Haiti) at the end of May, we learned of some **urgent needs** amongst our churches in Haiti and sent out a call to action. We praise God for the swift response of SPI Haiti partners! To date, we have **raised approximately \$28,000.00 of the targeted \$50,000.00** and have been able to assist with some of the following areas of need:

- Emergency funds for the families of Croix-des-Bouquets who are affected by the gang violence in Port-au-Prince: \$22,000.00
- Emergency funds for the Regional Lead Church (Jacmel) to disburse as needed, as people are affected by the rising cost of living: \$18,000.00
- Funds to cover transportation and power issues at Harvest Jacmel: \$10,000.00
